



## Call for “Poster & Discourse”

The 29<sup>th</sup> Congress of the German Society for Educational Research will be held in Halle, Germany, from March 10<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The theme of the conference is: “Crises and Transformations” (<https://dgfe2024.philfak3.uni-halle.de/english/>).

The session “Posters & Discourse” is conceived as an opportunity for the graphic and interactive presentation of projects and plans in educational research. In order to emphasize discussion and networking, this part of the conference is deliberately intended to facilitate discourse in addition to visual presentations (each a DIN A1 portrait print or 23.4 x 33.1 inches). For this purpose, a hybrid format for these presentations is being offered.

In-person poster presentations will take place on March 11, 2024, between 1:00 and 2:15 pm. In addition to this face-to-face event, there will be opportunities for remote exchange during the week before and the week after the congress, so that the projects featured in the poster presentation can be fully explored and discussed. In addition, poster preparation workshops will be offered during the preparation period.

Submissions may be a) related to the theme of the Congress or b) presented as separate research projects. We ask that all submissions be described using three to five keywords to assist in organization. We welcome innovative methodological approaches as well as research that addresses current issues.

Poster submissions can be submitted via the ConfTool link (<https://www.conftool.pro/dgfe2024/>) up to September 15, 2023. The abstract cannot exceed 2,500 characters (including spaces and references). During the presentation in Halle, at least one member of those responsible for the poster must participate in-person at the poster session. The text of the abstract is to be submitted anonymously, as the review is anonymous.

A poster preparation workshop will be held in October 2023 for all researchers who have submitted an abstract. Feedback on acceptance will be provided by mid-November 2023. For those whose contribution has been accepted, a more in-depth workshop will be offered in December 2023. Finally, the poster to be exhibited should be submitted in digital form by January 31, 2024, so that it can be made digitally visible and accessible before and after the congress.

All congress participants are invited to attend the central session on March 11, 2024, and both before and after, to talk remotely with the authors about their work.
