

AdHoc groups – Call for Papers

The 29th Congress of the DGfE will take place from March 10th to the 13th, 2024, at the Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg, Germany. The congress offers participants different formats for presentation, exchange, and debate relevant to the congress theme "Crises and Transformations" and to other contemporary issues in educational research. The submission of proposals for working groups, symposia, research, and thematic forums has already concluded. With this current call, submissions for ad-hoc groups are invited.

Ad-hoc groups (90 minutes) will be offered on March 12, 2024. The content of ad-hoc groups includes disciplinary and science policy issues. The substantive design of knowledge presentation is the responsibility of the submitter, and both classical and alternative design formats are welcome. However, the design approach should be justified in the submission. Contributions that have been rejected for other session formats (e.g., working groups or symposia) cannot be resubmitted as ad-hoc groups. The evaluation of the submitted ad-hoc groups will be carried out by the local organizing committee.

Contributions for ad-hoc groups, like all other contributions, should be submitted electronically via ConfTool for the DGFE Congress (https://www.conftool.pro/dgfe2024/). Submissions can be made from October 2nd to November 26th. A maximum of 4,000 characters is available for the joint abstract, which should clearly present the content and conceptual design of the planned ad-hoc group. This abstract should be supplemented with a summary for the program, with a maximum length of 1,000 characters. In the case of individual presentations or longer discussion contributions within the ad-hoc groups, each should be accompanied by an additional abstract of no more than 1,500 characters in the submission.
